We need all members to sign so that we can attempt to prevent this shelter being established in our community. Time is of the essence, so please sign as soon as possible. Future notice will be communicated about any public meetings concerning this shelter.

Membership Meeting Government Restrictions

Due to Governor Inslee Order, all general meetings are cancelled until we are allowed 50% of membership to meet. Currently our club house has a maximum capacity of 63 people. We need to have at least 50% occupancy to hold a meeting which would allow for 31 people to meet in the club house at any one time. Currently we are allowed 25% which is only 16 people that is just the board members. Board meeting are authorized on the 4th Monday at 1800. If you have something that needs to be address, please bring it up to a board meeting. The range is open but you must maintain 6 feet from each other while on the range.

In light of the NRA filing for bankruptcy protection, CWSA is temporarily suspending NRA renewals. If you recently renewed through the club AND WE HAVE NOT SUBMITTED YOUR MONEY, we will be returning that to you. Once this is sorted out we will return to our normal renewal process.

Membership Renewal

Just a reminder about membership applications: If you live off Whidbey Island you are allowed to mail in your application to renew your membership. I strongly recommend you give Wes Kenworthy a call at (360) 675-3524 before you write out your check to ensure it is for the correct amount and that you send in your key taped to a piece of card stock along with your application, so processing your membership will not be delayed. If you live on Whidbey Island you are not allowed to mail in your membership application, but you need attend one of the renewals or new member orientations to renew your membership as noted on the far right side of the application where it states "off island residents only".

Online Vote to amend Bylaws and Authorized Purchase of Tables:

VOTING RESULTS FOR TABLES AND BYLAWS:

The voting for the tables is complete with 162 members in favor of buying the tables and only 1 no vote. So we will look at buying 4-8' tables for no more than \$620.00, But we will research further to find a cheaper price before we buy.

The voting on the bylaws were 160 members in favor of changing the bylaws to allow the board members to spend up to \$600.00 vise \$300.00 without membership approval with only 3 no votes, so it has passed as well.

Working Party Notes & Next Work Party(s)

Gary Winlund will retire from being our maintenance supervisor at the end of the year. The club is looking for 3 people to replace him, so we can split up the service project coordinators, one person for Sunday's work party and one person for Wednesday's work party and one person for club maintenance. These 3 people will work together and be a committee to take care of the club with membership help. If you are interested in replacing Gary Winlund please let Gary or myself know so Gary can start training those people on what they need to know. Gary has done an outstanding job for many years and would like to take life a little easier. He will train the committee with everything they need to know including the Tractor, well house maintenance, budget, contact information on where to buy supplies and much more.

Empty garbage cans, including brass barrels on ranges. Extra bags should be available in cans.
