ALL PISTOLS & REVOLVER SHOOTING IS OFFHAND 1 OR 2 HANDS, NO MAGNUM LOADS. A
22 PISTOL AND RIFLE WILL BE PROVIDED WITH AMMO

1. Briquettes @ 10 yds. 6 Briquettes break the most without hitting the cardboard tube.
Any pistol/ revolver using iron sights only.
2. Shotgun Pig Shoot @ 25yds. 2 Shotshells, Most pellets in the white center wins.
Shotgun and Ammo Provided
3. Dart Shoot @ 10yds. 6 shots highest score wins.
Any pistol/ revolver using iron sights only.
4. Poker Hand @ 10yds. 5 shots highest hand, **Any pistol/ revolver using iron sights only.**
5. Rifle Shoot @ 50yds. 6 shots @ Bullseye target, **22 rim-fire rifle, iron sights only.**
Club rifles off hand & Juniors Bench rest.
6. Trap Shoot--- Best of 10 “Bring your shotgun and shells.
7. “Ages 15 and under will shoot the junior class at the 50-yard bullseye”. Rifle and ammunition provided,

Shoot offs as needed, will be held @ 12:30pm
