

### **Board Meeting – Items of Interest:**

CWSA membership prices for 2022 will stay the same as the 2021 membership costs. The board voted tonight not to raise membership.

Just a reminder on 2 October 2021 from 0900 to 1:00pm is **our annual charity match** with all donations going to WAIF this year. Turkeys will be provided to first and second place winner!
