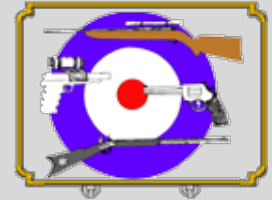

It is Spring. The sun is out and there are shooting matches scheduled. Check the calendar on the website for something that interests you. Come out and shoot, or watch. Maybe after watching you will want to get involved. If you are interested in participating, check out the "Match rules" section of the website for more information about the individual matches and the gun and ammo requirements.

### What you absolutely, positively MUST know:

**The shotgun (ammo) rules have recently changed.** You can fire a shotgun with shot **Birdshot** in the trap range, at the patterning board at the end of the trap range and in Bay #6. In Bay #6 they have set up hog wire to hold targets or paper to check out your shotgun - bring some clothes line clips or tape. You can fire **Slugs** at the 100yd and 200yd range as well as the short range - this is for sighting purposes only. Please limit the number of slug rounds that you fire on these ranges due to the damage they do.

## **Board Meeting – Items of Interest:**

Wes Kenworthy reports that we currently have 556 members.

We will sponsor CPR / First Aid classes on 11 June from 13:00 to 17:00 and 8 October from 08:00 to noon. Classes will be taught by the Oak Harbor Fire Department. Seating will be limited to 15 people. The first fifteen people to sign up will get the seats. Classes are free of charge. If you put your name on the list, you have to show up! An E-mail will go out this week to the membership showing the times and dates of the classes. Dates and times are already on the calendar.

The club is in the process of changing to a new electronic sign-in system, "EZ-Facility." This system will merge membership status with club access and entry and exit records. The new system will also change annual membership renewal from a few hours available for you to stand in line at the club and pay by check to pay by credit card (preferable method on payment) through the website while wearing your pajamas at home. Your access card will be updated and authorized at the club, front gate, automatically (or manually by the club committee chair). Which reminds me, who wants to volunteer to help Wes Kenworthy with the data transfer and maintenance? The club directors are easing into this system, slowly, to prevent any disruptions. In June, we will enter into a three-month trial period to test some of the systems in EZ-Facility. If all works well, we will implement it on a year-by-year basis.
