

Are you interested in a concealed carry class using the Utah protocol? You must have the Washington permit to apply for the Utah permit. Contact Randy Pike RW_Pike@yahoo.com or at (360) 544-2140 if you are interested.

Randy Pike is helping to organize a class which qualifies you to get a UTAH CCL, this has reciprocity in many states so it may be useful for those who travel. A requirement for this is **you must already possess a Washington CCL**. You get this by applying at the local Police Department if you live in a city or the County Sheriff's Office if you live in the unincorporated areas of the county.

ALL PISTOLS & REVOLVER SHOOTING IS OFFHAND 1 OR 2 HANDS, NO MAGNUM LOADS. A 22 PISTOL AND RIFLE WILL BE PROVIDED WITH AMMO

1. Briquettes @ 10 yds. 6 Briquettes break the most without hitting the cardboard tube.

Any pistol/ revolver using iron sights only.

2. Shotgun Pig Shoot @ 25yds. 2 Shotshells, Most pellets in the white center wins.

Shotgun and Ammo Provided

3. Dart Shoot @ 10yds. 6 shots highest score wins.

Any pistol/ revolver using iron sights only.

- 4. Poker Hand@ 10yds. 5 shots highest hand, any pistol/ revolver using iron sights only.
- 5. Rifle Shoot @ 50yds. 6 shots @ Bullseye target, 22 rim-fire rifle, iron sights only.

Club rifles off hand & Juniors Bench rest.

- a. There's also a women's class 50 yard rifle.
- b. Junior's class age 14 and under 50 yard rifle.
- 6. Trap Shoot--- Best of 10 "Bring your shotgun and shells.

Shoot offs as needed, will be held @ 12:30pm

One Turkey limit per individual for the day

Bring your pistol/revolver **No Magnums**/ **Hot Load**, 22 pistol & shotgun with ammunition. If you do not have a 22 pistol, we will supply one with ammunition. The club will provide 22 rifles and ammo for the Bullseye event.
