There is talk riding on the wind that after 64 years in business Greene's Gun Shop is going to call it quits. We think you are entitled to know the reason why.

The state is planning to institute a new demand on those of us in business that have F.F.L's. Because they've allowed crime to get out of control they're now putting the blame on us and making demands a shop our size can in no way meet.

I'm sending here a link to the proposed laws that are due to go in effect in August 2025 closing small gun shops such as ours and making it hard to impossible for larger shops as well.

Gun Owners Of America, Citizen Committee For The Right To Keep And Bear Arms are both very instrumental in our fight.. There are others too of course such as the Gun Owners Of America and the NRA. These are all organizations we support because they are supporting us,

This is one of those "Don't Know What You've Got Till It's Gone" situations...don't just dismiss this threat and let it go by...it's very. real. As it stands it's extremely likely that one day soon when you show up at one of your favorite gun stores you'll discover it's no longer there. Your gun rights are at stake...if you don't support those who defend them then don't expect others to do so for you. We can't do this alone. We're all in this together and we must work together if we are to prevail.
