CWSA General Meeting Minutes

Date: 12 August 2024

General Business Reports

Secretary, Reading of Previous Minutes: Previous minutes are posted online.

Treasurer's Report: Our bank balance, effective today, is \$190,370.00. The only news is that we have repaired the well; however, we have not been billed, as yet. The electrical portion of the bill should run about \$200.00. This is for materials only, as the labor was donated by a club member.

Membership Report: Larry Memmer reports we had 942 members and picked up three more members tonight, bringing us up to 945. 7 September will be our last new-member orientation of the year.

Public Relations Report: Bill was not here tonight.

Club Maintenance Report: Ed Hilkey reports the following maintenance work has been completed:

- The new roof for the pin range has been completed.
- We are getting close to finishing up on range 9.
- Next, we will start on the old short range.
- Gary Winlund and Dave Denning completely rebuilt the 200-yard range. We need to ask Ed for the remaining names.
- Ed's final goal before winter is to rebuild the 100-yard range.
- NOTE: Range 9 will be a pistol only range for the time being.

NRA Membership: Nothing to report

NRA Training: No new information. The past few times we have tried to sponsor an NRA training session we have had poor turnouts due to the high cost. Possibly we will want to sponsor a class with our own training material and avoid the extra expense of using the NRA.

RSO Report: Nick is not here tonight, but he sent some info by email. No issues noted but he would like to mention brass clean up following your shoot. Please take your brass home!

Hat Sales / Fund Raising: Linda reports that we had no hat sales tonight and also at our last general meeting.

Old Business

1. Update membership on the U.S. Border Patrol's desire to use the CWSA range for agent training. They plan to shoot 250,000 rounds per year, which could be a long-term maintenance consideration for the club. Linda mentioned that Skagit has a firm that mines the lead for them and pays them for the lead. Bob brings this up because we have multiple requests for range use, by outside agencies. We need to think this through and understand the potential impacts on the club. Gary Raster mentioned that the Holms Harbor range mines their lead every ten years. Gray R suggests that we put together a committee to determine the viability of mining our lead.

2. Michael Poggie, 2019 Revolver World Champion has requested to use the range as his personal training site. He is asking for a special rule dispensation to allow him to use his personal targets for training. In addition, he would like exclusive use of bay 5 or 8 for his training, possibly one day per week. Larry Memmer made a motion to approve Michael's request with a second coming from Al Lindell. The board passed the motion; however, Michael will have to join the club, and the executive committee will need to write a letter specifying the exceptions to our standing rules. Michael has joined the club. This item was added to the meeting agenda solely to bring the members up to speed on this issue.

New Business

- Introduce membership to recent problems with the club's well and subsequent repairs actions taken by the board: Bob Clark brought the membership up to speed on the ownership of the well and the neighbor's responsibility of maintenance. Bob rehearsed the actions taken by the board for the club to pay for half of the well pump replacement with the neighbors Michael Harrison and Ron Martin each contributing 25% (\$1,200.00) each. This action does not relieve Michael and Ron or any subsequent property owners of responsibility of well maintenance—it is only a gesture of being a good neighbor, on the club's part. Larry Memmer made a proposal for the general membership to approve the board's action. The motion was seconded by Dale Fespar. The motion was passed by the membership.
- 2. At the last board meeting, Larry Memmer proposed awarding life membership to Kirby Stevens for his outstanding service as membership secretary for six years and his continued support since Wes Kenworthy's unfortunate medical situation. Doug Smith made a motion to make the award, and the motion was seconded by Alex Jackson and passed by the board. This item was posted here for general membership information only.
- At the last board meeting, Larry Memmer also proposed awarding life membership to Ralph Downs who has run our trap range for the past 15 to 20 years. Ralph has also been learning the EZF membership program and helping with membership renewals. Ralph has also been helping with the hunter's education program for the past three years. Doug Smith made a motion to make an award of life membership to Ralph. The motion was seconded by Alex Jackson and passed unanimously by the board. Again, this item was posted here for general membership information only. 4. Plans for a possible membership appreciation day: Bob has looked at the cost of sponsoring a membership appreciation day. He feels that it would cost us about \$300.00 for 100 people. Bob feels that we will need a firm commitment from people that are willing to help. Also, we would need to send out a global email through EZF to the members to get a commitment for attendance. Ralph would like to get a firm date.
- 4. Bob is thinking about the end of the month. This item was tabled. We will bring this up for next year when we have more time to adequately plan the event.
- Zig Zenes mentions that he has been working with Washington F&G to sponsor shotgun wad clean up on Whidbey Island beaches. Since the club is not a water foul club, it was suggested that Zig contact Ducks Unlimited.
- 6. Ed Hilkey made a request to purchase enough 5/8 gravel to cover

- ranges 6, 7 and 9. Gary Raster made a motion to allow Ed to spend up to \$4,000.00 for sand and gravel for range improvement. The motion was seconded by Kirby Stevens and passed by unanimous vote of the membership present.
- 7. Gary Winlund related his recent experience with a silhouette shoot where only thirteen people showed up. Gary would like to spend \$394.04 to purchase additional targets which would allow up to 21 people to participate in silhouette shoots. Larry Memmre made a motion to approve the expenditure, and the motion was passed by the membership.
- 8. Introduction of New Members: Mike Bradford introduced himself tonight as a new member and was welcomed by the membership.
