

#### **General Business Reports**

Secretary, Reading of Previous Minutes: Previous minutes are posted online.

**Treasurer's Report:** We deposited \$2,700.00 in the bank today after our membership drive on Saturday. Included in that amount is the \$600.00 that we received from State Parks. Our current balance is \$190,008.00, which includes our petty cash of \$800.00 in Ed's working account. Our CD currently has a value of \$101,816.00.

Membership Report: Current membership stands at 974 members. This past week we gained 28 new members. Al Lindell brings up the concern of exceeding 1000 members, which would increase our EZF fees. Ralph advises that our EZF fee will only go up by \$18.00 per month. Larry says that he isn't concerned because we typically lose 150 members at the beginning of the year.

Public Relations Report: Bill is not here tonight.

**Club Maintenance Report:** 

**Ed reports:** Hopefully will get range 9 done next week we are waiting on jute which should be here now. Ed and Gary should be able to get going on it tomorrow.

Ed reports that the work party has finished cutting all of the boards for the eyebrows. We had a really good turnout on both Saturday and Sunday. All of the targets on the 100-yd range and the short-range pits have been refurbished. Bob suggests everyone take a look at ranges 6 and 7 and see how nice it looks.

NRA Membership: Nothing to report.

NRA Training: We are finding that people think that the NRA fees for the classes are too expensive at \$150.00. Larry says that if we do get something scheduled to let him know and he will get on the web site. We are reminded that the advantage of the NRA training is that you get a certificate that is nationally transferrable.

RSO Report: Nick not here tonight.

**Hat Sales / Fund Raising:** Linda reports that we sold one hat on Saturday. The 50/50 raffle pool is at \$9.00.



#### **Old Business**

Status of Bob Clark and Gary Raster's letter of rule modification for Michael Poggie has been finished.

Larry Memmer: Report on hunter's education program. Just finished hunter's education class with 14 students. Of the 14 we had two failures, which is unusual. All-in-all we did three classes this year one with 17 people, a second with 12 and this one with 14 students. Larry is also going to start a one-day hybrid class in January and one in May.

#### **New Business**

Update membership regarding the most recent problems with our well and decisions made by the board. Bob reports to the members that we are having problems with the well again. This time the pressure tank failed. When the electrician was finishing up the wiring for the pump, he noticed that the pump was cycling. After looking into it, we found that the original tank was installed incorrectly and did not have the ability to charge. Ed presented a quotation from Aquateck in Sedro Wooley to replace the old tank. Kirby made a motion to have Aquateck install the new tank for no more than \$3,000. The motion was seconded by Alex Jackson and was passed unanimously.

Gary Winlund brought up that we need to refill our supply of 22 training ammo. Bob mentions that most of this is used for the women's training sessions. Gary and Ed have found a decent price for 10,000 round lot



of 0.22 caliber long rifle for \$600. Broger made a motion to spend up to \$800.00. The motion was seconded by Larry Memmer and passed by the members.

**The charity shoot**: One of the members brought up the question of the annual charity shoot. Bob reported that no planning has been done this year. No body is raising their hand to plan the shoot, so we will pass this year.

Steve Foster brings up the issue with state parks and knowing what parts of the facility they will be using. Bob is trying to work out an agreement with parks to define what parts of the range will be closed to members. Ralph brings up that the calendar shows the sherif's use in RED which means exclusive use, which runs off some of our members.
