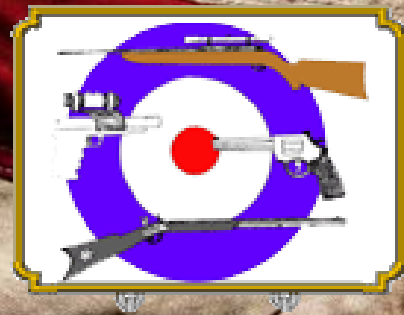

General Business Reports

Secretary, Reading of Previous Minutes: Minutes of the previous meeting are posted online

Treasurer's Report: President's petty cash fund was reported at the last meeting as \$800.00 it is actually \$500.00. We currently have \$230,420 in the bank. Recent major expenses include: \$5,700.00 in liability insurance, we still owe \$2000.00 for the carpet. The total carpet bill came in just under \$10,000.00

Membership Report: Larry reports that our current membership is 908. We should have three new people at our next orientation. Larry reiterated his plans to retire at the end of the year.
