Secretary, Reading of Previous Minutes:

Membership Report: Saturday 9 December before 10:00am we had 9 people renew from home. We had 23 pay by credit card, 19 pay by check and 1 person paid cash for 34 members updated their membership that day.

Public Relations: Not present at the meeting.

Work Projects: Ed. Ed needs to find out how many adopt-a-range signs we need to have made. We need one for each range. We also would like the sportsman of the year sign to have the same removable name plates. Kirby made a motion that we only buy signs for the ranges where we already have volunteers signed up. He suggests we purchase 9 signs to cover our current needs. The motion was motion was seconded by Doug Smith and the motion passed. Al already has three or four people working the pin range.

Ed went down to the county and got us a new stop sign and will be setting it on a new post. In addition, we would like to thank Ed for his help installing our new Starlink® internet antenna.

New Business

Change bylaws, Article 2 Section A, to exempt members older than 85 years from work party participation and still receive a membership discount.
