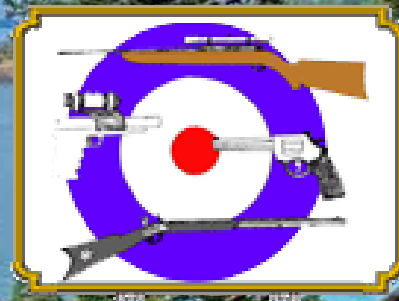

The state is planning to institute a new demand on those of us in business that have F.F.L's. Because they've allowed crime to get out of control they're now putting the blame on us and making demands a shop our size can in no way meet.

We're all in this together and we must work together if we are to prevail.
